Ozzy – Gypsy Cross Gelding
2021, 14.3hh, 1,135#, Sooty Buckskin

Diet – Fed free choice alfalfa along with turnout.

Farrier – Last shod on November 15th – He has been barefoot majority of his time with us; we put a full set on him to go to the Billings Sale before it was cancelled.

Dentist – Teeth floated September 9th

Chiropractor – Last went August 27th. This was not a “special” visit, all our horses go to the chiropractor.

Bits Used – Ozzy loves our medium hinge port bit. If you notice in most videos, he’s licking up his excessive drool from it. We ride him in a medium shanked snaffle as well and a smooth French link when English.

Blanket Size – A size 72” or 74” fits him best depending on the cut. He has been blanketed when 35 and under.

Extra Info – Like most young ones, he can get fresh with time off. If he’s had some time off, we do lunge him prior to getting on for a couple minutes. He’s never bolted, reared, kicked, or any of the sort but has done the gypsy hump around when fresh. He’s extremely brave and surefooted in rough country. If you point him somewhere, pitch him his head and he’ll get you to the other side. He has gotten along with all geldings, mares, and ponies at our place with no issue and does not have any vices in a stall.
